**MEMORIZE**

*The beginning of the Story is called **Creation**.*

*The Creator is **God**.*

*God is **perfect**.*

*God created **everything**.*

*God created everything **out of love and for His glory**.*

**CHAT**

*Q: What did we learn about God?*

A: He is the source of all that exists. He is the master artist. He creates out of love, for Himself. Psalm 90v2: everlasting to everlasting. God has always been.

*Q: Who is the source of everything?*

A: God. (Father, Son, Spirit.)

*Q: What did God create?*

A: Everything. What specifically is mentioned?

*Q: Why did God create?*

A: For love's sake and for His glory. His love and glory are the central motives of creation.

*Q: Where/how do we see the gospel?*

A: Psalm 19: Creation declares God's glory. The gospel is the power of God; the psalmist writes of God's power to create new things. The gospel makes us new.
