MEMORIZE

*At the beginning of the Story there is a **garden**.*

CHAT

Q: What did we learn about God?

A: God makes beautiful things. God is the one who puts everything in its right place. Eden was created out of love and for God. True, real love made Eden special.

Q: Why was Eden special?

A: Eden was created out of love and for God. True, real love made Eden special.

Q: What do you think it means that everything was in its right and proper place?

A: God is good, right, and perfect, so all He does is good, right, and perfect.

Q: What do you think God meant when He said "it is very good"?

A: There was no mistake. God created out of love and fullness. Creation was perfect. Everything was separated perfectly into its specific place and category.

Q: What did Eden represent?

A: Goodness, love, rightness, home, belonging, relationship, worship. Eden represented God.

Q: Where/how do we see the gospel?

A: We see God's power on display. There is now life where there was once nothing.
